Please join us on Monday October 8th for a Student Expo associated with the Annual Meeting for the Eastern Section of the American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG) at the Wyndham Grand Hotel in downtown Pittsburgh. The meeting from October 7-11 is in conjunction with Annual Meeting of the Eastern Section of the Society of Petroleum Engineers. It should be a well-attended meeting and a great place to network.

The Student Expo is an event exclusively for students! The good part! Attendance at the EXPO with lunch is free, and if you attend the Eastern Section meeting, student registration is only \$50.

This year's AAPG Eastern Section Student Expo will use the same format as at the Section meeting in Morgantown, which worked well. There will be a short presentation by industry representatives, then a series of round-robin Q&A table discussions with company representatives, followed by informal lunch and if you want, the chance to present a poster.

Following the Expo there will be a 2 hr. Young Professional's activity with a Ducky Tour and Incline to Mt Washington, leaving the hotel at 1:30. (This is a free event open to all YP's and students, but you must pre-register to attend. See website for details.)
